Language Immersion: Wondering how kids learn language? So are we! Join Betsy Sneller, language researcher at Georgetown University (also known as Mr. Sneller's daughter and a grad of ZCS), and Jodi Pierce, director of ZCS's language immersion program, for a short language acquisition seminar on **Tuesday, December 11 at 7:00** in the media center. Betsy will talk about how researchers study language acquisition, what the field has uncovered so far, and some of the exciting questions they are still researching.
