Classes will be available in English and Spanish Immersion.

# Partnerships Ridge Point Community Church

Ridge Point Community Church approached Zeeland Christian in the Spring of 2019 about the idea of a nature-based preschool on their grounds. ZCS is in the midst of a nature-rich initiative on its own campus and with Ridge Point's emphasis on the Christian aspect of a nature-based preschool, it is a Spirit-led and natural partnership.

# **Outdoor Discovery Center**

We are excited to partner with the Outdoor Discovery Center Education Network as we launch Creation Ridge in the fall of 2020. Their expertise in outdoor education and nature-based preschool experiences will guide us as we start our own nature-based preschool through Zeeland Christian School.

# How do Creation Ridge classes look different than other Zeeland Christian Preschool classes?

- Classes are outside in all weather, except extreme weather conditions.
- There are required outdoor clothing items families need to purchase.
- The majority of class time is outdoors.
- Classes engage in an outdoor classroom and take daily hikes around the property.

# **Creation Ridge Registration Process**

Step 1: Enter the Lottery

- An online form will be available at zcs.org/creationridge starting Fri., Jan. 17 at 9 AM.
- Complete the form by Tues., Jan. 21 at 9 AM

Step 2: Lottery Selection

• You will **receive an email on Jan. 21 or 22** informing you of your child's class or waitlist placement.

Step 3: Register Online

- Complete your child's online registration at www.zcspreschool.eventbrite.com with the password you receive in your class placement email.
- Pay the \$55 registration fee (\$50 is applied to tuition)
- Finish this registration before 3:00 PM on Thurs. Jan. 23 or your child's spot will be given to another child.

### ZCS Extended Care 2020-2021

Our extended care programs are designed to support family child-care needs. All children must be pre-registered in order to attend Extended Care programs.

There is a \$30 registration fee per family, paid online at the start of the school year. If you are interested in enrolling your child in Extended Care, please indicate "Yes" on your online registration form. Then we know to send you the Extended Care registration information later this spring.

Before School Care - Cost \$6.50 per child/day, \$11.00 for 2 kids, \$15.00 for 3 kids

Offered everyday from 7:00AM-9:00AM Offered to preschool or elementary students (PS-5th) Nutritional breakfast provided

Morning Care - Cost \$15.00 per child/per day
Offered everyday from 8:30AM-11:30AM
Nutritional snack provided

Lunch Bunch - Cost \$7.00 per child/per day
Offered everyday from 11:30AM-1:00PM
Kids bring their lunch from home

Afternoon Care - Cost \$20.00 per child/per day
Offered everyday from 11:30AM-3:30PM
Kids bring their lunch from home
Nutritional snack provided

**After School Care** - Cost \$5.50 per child/per hour, \$10/hour for 2 kids, \$13/hour for 3 kids, billed in half hour increments

Offered everyday from 3:3OPM-6:0OPM
Offered to preschool and elementary students (PS-5th)
Nutritional snack provided

**Full Day Preschool Care** - Cost \$37 per child/per day (Kids can stay for After School Care (ASC), but cost of ASC is the same)

Offered everyday from 7:00AM-3:30PM

# What types of things will my child learn at Zeeland Christian Preschool?

Activities are designed to encourage growth in key developmental areas. A few examples:

### **Threeschool**

Counting

Early literacy behaviors

Recognizing his/her name

Colors and shapes

Vocabulary development

Eye-hand coordination

Taking turns, sharing, helping each other

Worshiping with friends

### Preschool

Letters, numbers, counting, colors, shapes

Name writing/recognition

Pre-writing skills

Language development and self-expression

Taking turns, sharing, helping each other

Worshiping with friends

# Are parents expected to help in the classroom?

We ask parents to volunteer as classroom helpers 2 times per school year. A parent or another special friend will help once at the start of the year and once at the time of the child's birthday or half birthday. Kids love the opportunity to show their loved ones what they do at school. If a parent or special friend cannot attend, please let us know.

## How do you handle food allergies?

We take allergies very seriously at ZCS and will work with you to put together a food plan. We will also try to accommodate food allergies when developing monthly menus. However, we do recommend providing "safe snacks" for children with severe allergies.

# Does my child have to be potty trained?

Yes. Children enrolled in Zeeland Christian Preschool must be toilet trained and independent in the bathroom. No pull-ups are allowed. Our staff will coach children in the bathroom but not physically assist them. (An exception can be made for children who have a specific plan with our support services staff.)

# Are there ways to help reduce the cost of preschool tuition?

There are a few different ways that you can help reduce the cost of preschool tuition:

# Tuition Reduction Incentive Program (TRIP)

Purpose: To provide current and future families an opportunity to reduce their tuition at ZCS by shopping with participating businesses.

### How it works:

Families purchase gift cards from participating businesses.

The businesses give back a certain percentage of each purchase to ZCS. The money given to ZCS goes into each family's account. This is then applied to your tuition balance in July or January upon request. Over time, the money can

add up.

"I highly encourage ZCS families to participate in TRIP since it is a very easy way to earn free money toward tuition. We primarily use TRIP for groceries and gas each week. With that alone we earn over \$500 per year toward our kids' tuition!" - Traci, ZCS Mom

# **Ready for School**

Income Eligibility Guidelines for Ready for School Tuition Assistance, 2019-2020

Ready for School is an organization in the Holland/Zeeland/Hamilton area that provides scholarships to three-year-olds based on income. The application process occurs online and is very straightforward. You apply directly with Ready for School, and then if approved for a scholarship, you just contact Nancy Pyle to let her know to be in touch with Ready for School to confirm your school of choice is Zeeland Christian. Here is the family size/income chart for the 2019-2020 school year. The updated chart for 2020-2021 will be available in April.

# How does ZCS keep the building secure?

Exterior doors at ZCS are kept locked during school hours except during drop-off times. Visitors must enter through the main ZCS office (off Central Ave.), sign in, fill out a name tag, and then sign out when they leave.

# What should I expect between registration and the first day of school?

Jan 30, 7:00 PM. Register online (zcspreschool.eventbrite.com).

March: Watch for a "Welcome" email from preschool staff

June: You will receive a class list and misc. enrollment forms by email.

July: Misc. forms are due back to ZCS

Aug.: Your child's teacher will mail you a back-to-school letter

Aug..: Parent meetings Sept.: Preschool begins!

### What path should my child take to get to kindergarten?

There are lots of paths that parents choose for their child's journey to kindergarten. Parents make choices based on their child's birthdate, time at home vs. time at preschool/childcare, family schedules, and more. There isn't a right or wrong answer on what's best for YOUR child. The state of Michigan requires that a child turns five by September 1, of the year he/she enters kindergarten. That means that all children should be five, turning six, during his/her kindergarten year. (Some children with late summer birthdays start kindergarten as six-year-olds.)

# Paths to Kindergarten

This is the traditional path that many families have chosen for their children.

Preschool Kindergarten

Threeschool is a great opportunity for children to learn how to "do school" before they begin the Kindergarten Readiness structure of Preschool. Our teachers have found that children who complete Threeschool are very well prepared for Preschool.

Threeschool Preschool Kindergarten

This is a good option for children who have birthdays between September 1 and December 1. If you think your child will benefit from a year of Young Fives (5 mornings a week), give your child a year of Preschool before beginning Young Fives.

Preschool Young Fives Kindergarten

If your child has a fall birthday but you are not ready to start them in Young Fives, start your child in Threeschool and then work with the classroom teacher to determine if Preschool or Young Fives is the best option for your child for the next year.

Threeschool Young Fives Kindergarten

This option includes three years of schooling before Kindergarten, but it may be a great option for a child with a summer birthday who enters Threeschool as a young three-year-old. Even after the year of Preschool is finished, Young Fives is an option to give the "gift of a year" to a child who still needs time to grow and develop skills before entering Kindergarten.

If your child has had good educational experiences outside of a school setting, he/she may do well with a year of Young Fives and then Kindergarten.
