Zeeland Christian School is a covenantal family made up of many parents. Many years ago the School Board decided that it would implement a sliding tuition schedule that would allow parents with more children to pay a lower percent of the cost of education.

If you have financial concerns about your ability to enroll your family at ZCS, please know that we have tuition assistance (T.A.) available. Over the last few years our families and donors have worked hard to be able to offer 80-100% of the assistance families qualify for. The qualifying formula for T.A. is:

Step 1: 18% x Adjusted Gross Income = X **Step 2:** Total tuition - X = T.A. amount a family qualifies for

*The ranges provided in the tuition schedule take into account our tuition assistance program. The largest tuition reduction a family can currently receive is 50%.



ZCS Extended Care 2020-2021

Our extended care programs are designed to support family child-care needs. All children must be pre-registered in order to attend Extended Care programs.

There is a \$30 registration fee per family, paid at the start of the school year. Contact Heather Mulder (<u>hmulder@zcs.org</u>) to register or for more information.

Before School Care - Cost \$6.50 for 1 child/day, \$11.00 for 2, \$15.00 for 3 Offered everyday from 7:00am-9:00am Offered to preschool or elementary students (PS-5th) Nutritional breakfast provided

After School Care - Cost \$5.50 per child/per hour, \$10/hour for 2, \$13/hour for 3, billed in half hour increments Offered everyday from 3:30pm-6:00pm Offered to preschool and elementary students (PS-5th) Nutritional snack provided



Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a dress code? We do not have a dress code besides being appropriate and modest.

How do you handle food allergies?

We take allergies very seriously at ZCS and will work with you to put together a food plan. Each family is contacted before school starts to determine the best plan for that child. However, we do recommend providing "safe snacks" for children with severe allergies.

How does ZCS keep the building secure?

Exterior doors at ZCS are kept locked during school hours except during drop-off times. Parents are given personal codes that can be used to enter the preschool entrance. Visitors must enter through the main ZCS office (off Central Ave.).

What extracurricular activities are available for elementary and middle school students? We have a variety of opportunities for 6th, 7th, and 8th graders to participate in sports at Zeeland Christian. Because of our close relationship with Holland Christian Schools we are also able to work together to offer even more opportunities, listed under Co-op sports below, that we wouldn't be able to provide on our own.

TRIP - Tuition Reduction Incentive Program (Preschool - 8th Grade)

Purpose

To provide current and future families an opportunity to reduce their tuition at ZCS by shopping with participating businesses.

How it works:

Families purchase gift cards through TRIP for participating businesses. The businesses give back a certain percentage of each purchase to ZCS. The money given to ZCS goes into each family's account. This is then applied to your tuition balance in July or January. Over time, the money can really add up!

Enrollment Process

Set up SMART Tuition Account

Every ZCS family has a SMART account which is used to pay tuition. You will receive an email from SMART tuition within a week after filling out the enrollment form with instructions on how to set up your account and tuition payment plan.
