Report Card Time! Tuesday, January 28 every Kindergarten through 8th-grade child brought home a report card in a sealed envelope. End of 2nd Marking Period was January 17. This is a great opportunity to take some time to celebrate your child's strengths and have some productive conversations about growth areas. Make a point to have some time alone with each of your children to notice how they are growing this school year.

Report Cards were posted in Infinite Campus Parent Portal on Tuesday, January 28. Infinite Campus Portal allows parents to view their own child's school records (grades/attendance, Transportation schedule, school schedule) anywhere, anytime through a secure web browser. If you do not have an Infinite Campus login please complete the <u>acceptable use policy</u> and return it to the ZCS office to receive your login credentials. (Please note Zeeland Public generously shares their Infinite Campus Portal with ZCS, so you log in under the Zeeland Public portal).
