PLEASE PLAN AHEAD

- Please **DO NOT** visit if you or a family member has any COVID symptoms or is ill.
- **Reduced indoor seating - Bar and Café seating/ tables will be at 50%. Please DO NOT SAVE TABLE SPACE within any dining or seating areas. You will be asked to leave if not eating within one of the dining areas! Please DO NOT leave personal items unattended.**
- **Outside food/ packed lunches shall be allowed on outdoor patio and the upstairs loft ONLY. No outside food/ packed lunches will be allowed on main floor.**
- **Lockers will be unavailable – Personal items should be left in vehicles. Customers WILL NOT be allowed to rest personal belongings on tables or floor space! All personal items left unattended will be removed.**
- **Face coverings must be worn, both inside and outside at ALL TIMES.**
- **Keep 6 ft distance in all areas of the resort inside and outside. Number of guests is limited for all indoor areas. Follow markings on the floor for 6 ft distance while in rental and lift ticket lines.**
- **Stay together with the family and friends you arrived with. There will be no single rider line for the Sweet Express.**
- **Ski/Snowboard Lessons will be limited – Contact Bittersweet Ski School for availability prior to arrival.**
