The Middle School Principal is a key academic and spiritual leader of the school, shaping and nurturing the learning environment of the middle school. This person is responsible for the day-today management of the 6th - 8th grade faculty and staff who serve 250 middle school students. The Middle School Principal coordinates administrative oversight and plans all phases of instructional leadership for the school including educational programming, administration, discipline, and counseling services. Additionally, this person is a key member of the ZCS leadership team, working collaboratively with the other members to lead the school.

Love God

- Sets the spiritual climate of the middle school.
- Guides teachers in the integration of faith and learning.
- Leads new teachers in their understanding of the partnership between home, church, and school.
- Cares for the staff, parents, and students with pastoral love and guidance.
- Leads with a restorative mindset in disciplinary situations.

Love Kids

- Monitors and tracks student performance, conduct, and discipline; keeps consistent and reliable records and reports
- Facilitates opportunities to connect with students by being present and available during arrival and dismissal, by appearing at school functions, and by meeting with students.
- Enforces disciplinary policies and procedures with students.
- Works closely with teachers to maintain positive student relationships and implement restorative practices.
- Participates in parent meetings and conferences and acts as an intermediary between parents, teachers, and students to deal with a variety of needs or issues.



Love Learning

- Oversees the daily management of the middle school classrooms.
- Supervises middle school teachers and staff, providing periodic observations and evaluations that are timely and constructive and completed based on the timetables set in collaboration with the Head of School.
- In collaboration with the Head of School and other leadership team members, leads the hiring of all middle school faculty and staff.
- Oversee mentor teachers as they guide new teachers, with relevant support from other directors.
- Ensures a productive learning environment through continual collaboration with the leadership team, teachers, students, and parents.
- Maintains competency and student academic achievement as prescribed by the school board.
- Leads weekly staff meetings.
- Interacts with various stakeholders to foster a positive relationship between the school and the community.
- Collaborates with the Director of Learning Innovation and Learning Innovation Team leaders in continuous improvement of curriculum, instructional materials, and professional development that align with local, state, and national standards.
